2,132 PASS THE BOARD EXAM

The PRC and BoA announced the results of the May 2015 CPA Licensure Examination in the PRC and BoA websites. 2,132 out of 5,959 passed the examination. The national passing percentage for this examination of 35.77% was lower than the 37.02% of the October 2014 examination.

“The BoA is pleased to welcome our 2,132 new CPAs. Of course, they would first have to take their oath before they can become full pledged CPAs. The oath taking in Manila is scheduled on July 1, 2015,” Chairman Joel Tan-Torres said.

Eunice Millicent Ong Li of Chiang Kai Shek College garnered a rating of 92.29% to emerge as number one in the board examinations.

The top performing schools in this examination following the criteria in Commission Resolution No 2010-547 are:

1. University San Carlos with a passing percentage of 88.06% with 59 passers
2. De La Salle University-Manila with a passing percentage of 81.18% with 69 passers.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be on May 27, 28 and 29, 2015. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 1 piece passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of P600 and Annual Registration Fee of P450 for 2015-2018.

Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.
