## ACCOUNTANCY BOARD DISCUSSES PLANS WITH nACPAE OFFICERS

The Board of Accountancy, which includes the three newly appointed members, met with the officers and members of the National Association of CPAs in Education last May 18, 2014 at PICPA Shaw to discuss matters pertaining to the accountancy education, CPA examination syllabus, and the recently concluded May 2015 CPA examination.

For the first time, the entire BoA was present to meet the nACPAE delegation. Chairman Joel Tan-Torres and Hon. Eliseo Aurellado, Board member with oversight over the education sector, discussed the forthcoming events in the education sector, including the forthcoming BoA CHED review of the Accountancy Program curriculum, inspection of accounting schools, review of the CPA Licensure examination syllabus.

Chairman Tan-Torres also commented, "We also intend to improve and expand the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) offerings for the accounting educators. Another project to be pursued is the enhancement of the internship program for accounting students that will result in a win-win scenario for both the student intern and the industry employers."
