PALAWAN ANC AT A GLANCE

More than 3,000 accountants gathered to attend the 70th Annual National Convention (ANC) in Puerto Princesa, Palawan from November 25 to 28, 2015. The ANC officially started with the keynote speech of Commission on Audit Chairman Michael Aguinaldo at the Puerto Princesa City Coliseum.

The BoA Chairman and members were in the ANC and discussed the various developments in the Expanding Horizon (EH) initiatives and the Six Point Strategic Plan of the accountancy profession during the Concurrent Sectoral Fora conducted separately by ACPAPP, ACPACI, NACPAE and GACPA in Citystate Asturias Hotel in Puerto Princesa, Palawan.

In the Forum, Chairman Joel Tan-Torres focused on the Quality Assurance Review and the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Accountancy Services. Vice Chair Gloria Baysa talked on the changes in the Accountancy Curriculum. Hon. Samuel Padilla discussed updates on the EH government projects. Hon. Concordio Quisaot talked on the proposed resolutions that will affect the CPAs in commerce and industry. Hon. Gerardo Sanvictores discussed the updates on CPD. Hon. Eliseo Aurellado lectured during the public hearing of CHED and BoA on the forthcoming four tracks of the accountancy education.

One of the most attended event in the ANC was the panel discussion on the evolving role of accountancy services on the global value chain and the ASEAN integration. The panelist that discussed various issues on the topic were BoA Chairman Joel Tan-Torres, Andrew Stone of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants, Dean Estelita Aguirre of the Asian Federation of Accountants, and Christian Lauron of SGV & Co. Dr. Cesar Mansibang of PICPA moderated the panel discussion.

There was also a panel discussion on the "The Next Generation of Filipino CPAs" that included Hon. Aurellado and Sanvictores as panelists.

The ANC had a successful conclusion on November 28.
